CHANGE IS COMING!

When I was in Lincoln last week, I saw some geese flying north. I realize that there are many geese living in Lancaster County now days year-round. Someone would probably tell me that it was just those which stay here year-round moving from one lake to another. OK that's true. But to me it was a reminder that Spring is coming! Some people are glad to see the winter come to an end and others are not so glad. Some can't wait for spring because they really like the spring season. There are others who are glad for the change because they really like the summer season that comes right behind spring. One thing is certain: Change Is Coming! You've probably heard it said that if things are not changing then we are dead. There's some truth to that, but still for many of us, it can be difficult to accept change. We often become so accustomed to and comfortable with things just the way they have been that we resist change. Sometimes we even engage in bitter disputes over change. Some might ask what does the Bible say about change? There are lots and lots of examples in the Bible when God wanted the people to change their thinking. One example is when the people of God found themselves far removed from Jerusalem. That's when God, through the prophet Jeremiah, asked them to do something radical, something the people thought they could never do. They were instructed to embrace the new community and become a part of it in various ways. They were instructed to pray for the community's wellbeing. God assured them that when the community prospered, they too would prosper. Yes, they were fearful of the unknown, but even though they were uncertain of what tomorrow would bring, God would still be with them. We all need to learn a lesson from that. When we take the attitude that God is "in the day" today, just as God will be "in the day" tomorrow, then we can feel safe and secure in the midst of change. Second Timothy chapter 2 and verse 14 says: "Remind them of this and warn them before God that they are to avoid wrangling over words, which does no good but only ruins those who are listening." We should embrace change and look for ways to glorify God. Let's all join together and work for harmony and unity within our church and within our community.

He shares history and interesting stories direct from the Bible and other Biblical sources! Please join us! All are Welcome!


