Dear Friends,

Did you realize that the happy face, or smiley face is 40 years old? About 40 years ago, Carnegie Mellon University professor, Scott E. Fahlman, used three keystrokes that suggest a horizontal smiley face. A colon, a hyphen and an ending parenthesis and there it is:-)

Today, the smiley face and other emotional icons are known as emoticons. They are used to help people express their feeling when they're typing a message. In fact, the smiley face © has generated a cottage industry. Smiley faces can be seen on just about anything. Except people!

People who have smiles on their faces not only look better, but they probably feel better. And they make others around them feel better, too. Too many people forget what their face looks like to others. They step into the world each morning with a grumpy face, or a worry face, or a frowning face, or a sad and resigned face. It might be a good thing every morning to do a face check: What does my face look like today?!?

Fortunately for us, God's face is constant. We're reminded of this in the Aaronic Benediction which is found in the Old Testament book of Numbers, chapter 6:25-26 "The Lord make his face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace."

With the spring season and Easter upon us, it should be easy to smile each day. But sometimes we need to be reminded about its importance. So let this be a gentle reminder to smile, especially in worship on Sunday. As we strive to reach others in our community for Christ, we need to think about our facial expression. Does the joy of our faith shine through, or are we grumpy, frowning and sad? Allow the Lord to make his face to shine upon you and receive the peace of God. Then you can find it easier to put on a happy face. ©
