Dear Friends,

I hope that Easter has meant a lot to you this year. It is a wonderful time for individuals, families, and congregations. Celebrating the gift of salvation that Christ has made possible for us through his death and resurrection.

Now, you've got to accept it and act on it. You might say, "But pastor I don't know how to do that!"

You may need to pray and say to God, "God, I'm scrapping Plan A. I know that I'll never earn my way to Heaven. I know I'll never be good enough. I've already blown it enough times to know I'm not going to make the 100% thing. So I'm asking You to work Plan B in my life.
