I want you to think about one moment in history. It was the moment that Pontius Pilate first encountered Jesus Christ!

The Gospel writers indicate that Pilate had no real power over Jesus. Pilate actually did not want any part of this scheme that the Sanhedrin had put together to have Jesus killed.

Pilate's encounter with Christ is universal. It's not just one man's experience. It's every person's encounter. We all have to decide: what are we going to do with this one called Christ? What will our verdict be about Jesus?

Now let me say, it is not solely a matter of what we do with Christ. It is what Christ is doing with us! Christ is not a passive victim waiting for us to say who he is before he can be who he is. He is who he is! The very Son of God!

Pilate didn't get to determine Christ's fate and neither do you and I. The truth is that He determined ours!

The defeat in this encounter is not the defeat of Christ, nor is it the defeat of Pilate. The defeat is that of sin and death when confronted by the grace of God. You will not find a more powerful encounter in all of history such as this.

EASTER is a time to celebrate this victory of God! It is when we pause to recall again how wonderful it is that God loved us so much that He would send His only Son, to die for us and then be raised again to newness of life.

You and I really need to give God thanks for this wonderful gift. I hope you will join with us as we rejoice and give praise to God for loving us and saving us. Come join us this EASTER!! You really need to give God thanks!


