Well, you know, Easter is a day for Christians to pump their fists in the air and say, “Yes, Yes, Yes.”

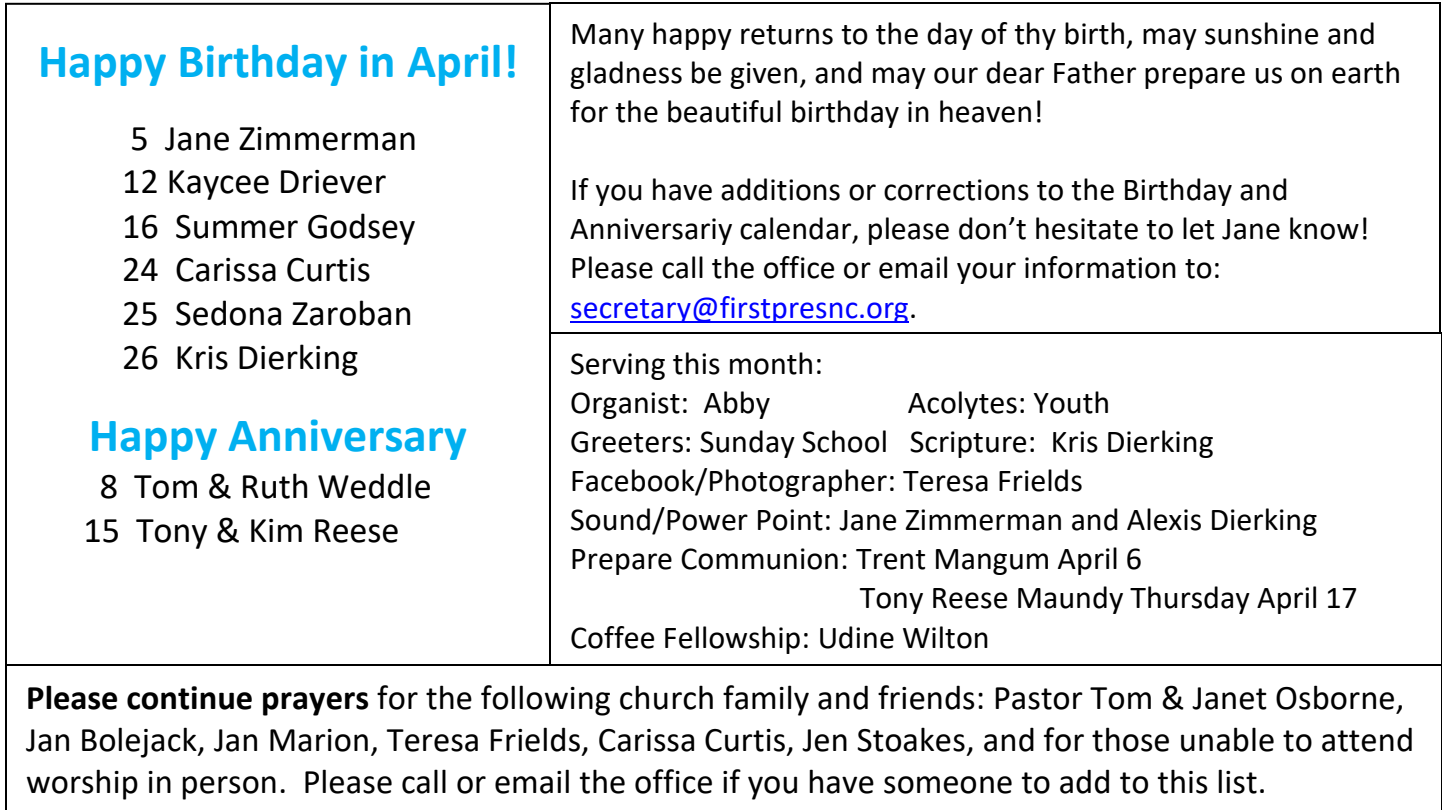
The Day of Resurrection is God’s yes to humanity, because God grants to us the gift of immortality.
